<b>Location of Field Trip:</b>	Mile Marker 13 (just past the Glen Cove gift shop at the switch back, where the creek goes under the road, before timberline at 11,000')
<b>Limitation on Number of Participants or Other Issues:</b>	No Limits! Kids are encouraged to participate.
<b>Brief Description of Field Trip:</b>	This is a digging trip to a Public Site. We will be joining our friends in the Lake George Gem & Mineral Club and the Denver Gem & Mineral Guild. No climbing gear is to be used!
<b>Are there any Special Costs such as Admission Charge or Charge for Transportation on a Bus:</b>	YES. We will benefit from a Group Rate of \$2 for children (6 - 15) and \$7 for adults (16 and over). Club Membership is Required! (you must be a member of CSMS, LGGMC, or DGMG)

<b>Est. Time of Return to Original Meeting Place:</b>	Departure time is voluntary. Please use the buddy-system going into the area & make sure your party leaves safely together. The gate closes at 7pm
<b>Vehicle Requirements, if any:</b>	Weather permitting, any vehicle should be okay.
<b>Physical Limitation Concerns, Including Accessibility to Handicapped Individuals:</b>	The site is at an approximate 10,500 ft. elevation, so those who have a difficulty with altitude should not participate. Not recommended for those who have difficulty in walking on uneven terrain. NO CLIMBING GEAR WILL BE ALLOWED
<b>Equipment or Tools Recommended or Required:</b>	A small pick and shovel, an old paint brush, an old screw driver, a rock hammer, safety glasses, and some sort of bucket or pack for carrying any specimens found. Also desirable are some paper for wrapping specimens.
<b>Availability of Water and Sanitary Facilities:</b>	None available. Bring Lunch, snacks and plenty of WATER !
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	The weather can change between morning and afternoon at this altitude and this time of the year. Wear appropriate clothing (layered) and hiking boots. Sunscreen is recommended. <i>It is important that you arrive on time and you follow the schedule.</i> <b>Please backfill any holes &amp; remember this is a high-profile area, so leave the public with a good impression of our club's conduct &amp; activities please!</b>
